**Would you like to be paid to take part in a citizens' jury?**

**Citizens' Juries Community Interest Company, a not-for-profit company, is inviting applications from members of the public who would like to take part in an exciting new project commissioned by the University of Manchester and the Information Commissioner's Office to explore what citizens think about computers making decisions, and what sort of explanation they should provide when they do. The results of the jury will inform national policy.**

**If selected, you will be part of a "citizens' jury" of 18 adults who will meet together in central Coventry between 09.30 and 17.00 on 18-22 February 2019. The jury will be given relevant information, and work together over the five days to answer important questions. **Interested in taking part?**

**You do not need any particular skills, knowledge or experience to be a member of the citizens' jury. No CV is required. People will be selected so that the jury comprises a cross-section of the public.**

**You can apply if:**

- **You are 18 or over;**
- **You have been a resident of England for at least the past year;**
- **You do not work or have special knowledge or experience of artificial intelligence or data protection;**
- **You can commit to all 5 days of the jury, from 18 to 22 February 2019, 09.30 to 17.00 each day, in central Coventry.**

**If selected, you will be paid £500 for the five days by the University of Manchester approximately four weeks after the jury. You will also be paid £20 in cash on the first day of the jury.**

**To apply to take part in the jury, press the "Next" button below, and complete this on-line survey form by no later than midday, Wednesday 2 January 2019 (although it may end sooner if sufficient applications are received). It takes about 5 minutes to complete.**
